Sub: Introduction of the method of Joint Locking System of Operation in all PEG godowns.

Sirs,

I am directed to request you to kindly take necessary steps to ensure that the prevalent practice of holding of all keys by the Private Entrepreneurs concerned is discontinued and the method of Joint Locking System of Operation, in which one set of keys shall be retained by the Private Entrepreneur and another set of keys shall be retained either by the godown-in-charge or by any authorized officer of WBSWC/WBECSC Ltd. , as the case may be (so that neither the private Entrepreneur nor the godown-in-charge/authorized officer will be able to operate the godown alone), is introduced and followed with an immediate effect in all PEG godowns that are presently being managed by WBSWC and by WBECSC Ltd. in the interest of proper storage management at these PEG godowns.

Furthermore, you are also requested to kindly make sure the method of Joint Locking System of Operation is practiced, since inception, in all PEG godowns that will be managed by WBSWC/WBECSC Ltd. in future.
